For more than eight persons add \$11,092 to the yearly income for each additional person in the household, and \$5,546 to the six month income.

The City of Pittsburgh sets Learn & Earn income eligibility using a combination of regulations. The 2024 eligibility has been set using TANF and 2023 CDBG income guidelines.

### Learn & Earn Frequently Asked Questions

What is Learn & Earn?

Learn & Earn is a six-week summer employment program for Allegheny County and City of Pittsburgh residents ages 14–21. Participants have the opportunity to earn money, gain work experience, and develop soft skills to help become college and career ready. Young adults between 18–24 are invited to apply for the Corporate Internship Program. What are the dates of Learn & Earn?

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The orientation week is June 17, 2024 through June 21, 2024. The work period runs for 6 weeks, June 24, 2024 to August 2, 2024.

All eligible participants who accept a position for the summer will be paid at a rate of \$9.00 per hour. Youth who are selected for the competitive

Corporate Internship Program (ages 18-24) can

earn up to \$ 12.00 per hour.

How much can I earn?

Who can apply?

The application is open to Allegheny County and/or City of Pittsburgh residents who meet program income requirements (see p. 3). All youth working in the general Learn & Earn program must be between the ages of 14 and 21 on June 17, 2024.

How many hours can I work?

Youth can work as many as 25 hours per week, Monday through Friday, for a maximum of 150 hours during the summer program. Corporate Intern young adults can work as many as 35 hours per week and 280 hours during the program.

What information do I need to apply?

Applicants will need some basic information to verify age, address, household income, work permit, and identity. A complete list of required documents is on page 4 of this packet.

How do I know if I've been placed with a Provider?

Once youth are made eligible for Learn & Earn, they are placed with a Provider organization based on their location, career interests, and positions available. Youth will be notified by a Provider if they are placed. Be sure to check your email to ensure your application has been submitted.
