



The above table shows percent decrease/increase in online job ads on a month over month/year over year basis. In April 2025, there were **4.6% fewer** online job advertisements in all occupations compared to April 2024. April 2025 had a **6.7% decrease in online job ads** compared to March 2025. Healthcare Practitioners and Technical occupations had the **largest YoY negative change** in job ads with **23.7% fewer online job ads** in April 2025 compared to April 2024. Even though job advertisements are down **4.6%** between April 2024 and April 2025, there are still more job advertisements than unemployed workers in Allegheny County.
