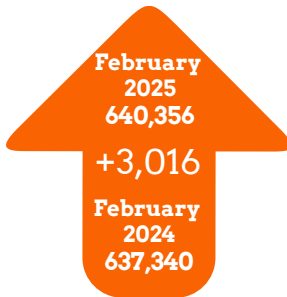

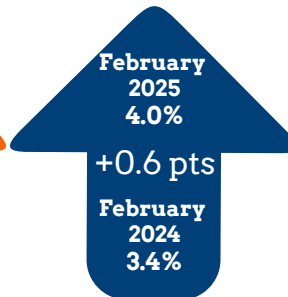

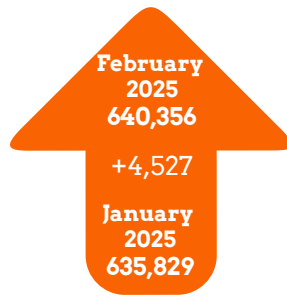
Labor Force Change  
1 Year



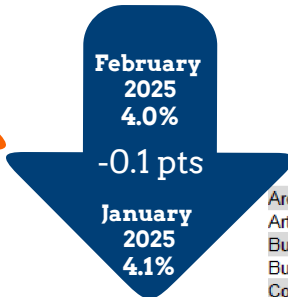
Unemployment Rate Change

1 Month

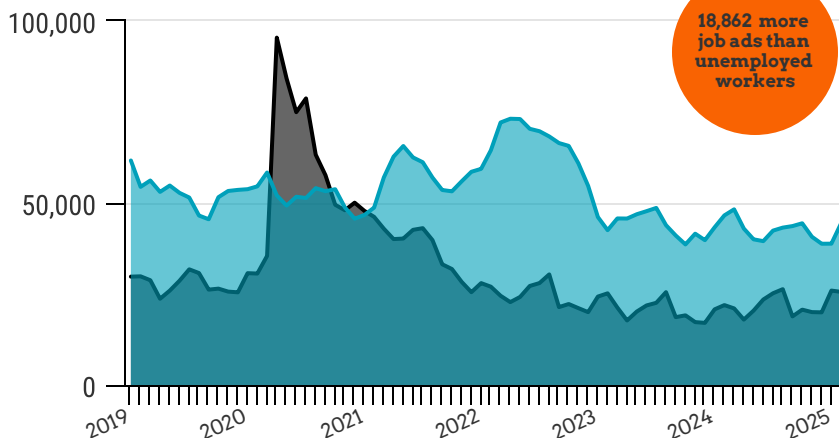


Unemployment Rate Change

The above table shows percent decrease/increase in online job ads on a month over month/year over year basis. In February 2025, there were **4.7% fewer** online job advertisements in all occupations compared to February 2024. February 2025 had an **3.6% increase in online job ads** compared to January 2025. Healthcare Practitioners and Technical occupations had the **largest YoY negative change** in job ads with **33.1% fewer online job ads** in February 2025 compared to February 2024. Even though job advertisements are down **4.7%** between February 2024 and February 2025, there are still more job advertisements than unemployed workers in Allegheny County.
