



The above table shows percent decrease/increase in online job ads on a month over month/year over year basis. In May 2025, there were **1.3% more** online job advertisements in all occupations compared to May 2024. May 2025 had a **1.3% decrease in online job ads** compared to April 2025. Life, Physical, and Social Science occupations had the **largest YoY negative change** in job ads with **17.6% fewer online job ads** in May 2025 compared to May 2024. With job advertisements up **1.3%** between May 2024 and May 2025, there are still more job advertisements than unemployed workers in Allegheny County.
